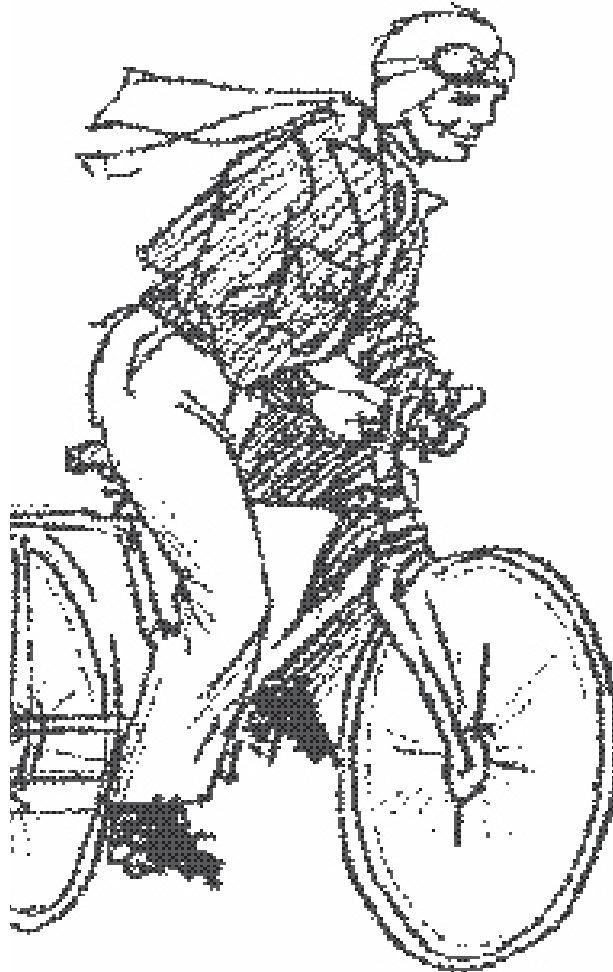
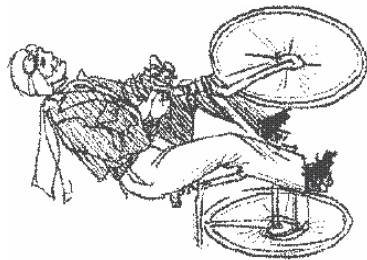

- Registration is 7:00-9:00am. **Century riders must start by 8:00am.**
- Ride includes maps, commemorative T-shirt, minor repair service and SAG stops with water, fruit and snacks every 10 to 17 miles.
- Support vehicles and SAG stops on route between 8:00am and 4:00pm to offer assistance or aid those unable to complete the ride
